## 1. “Header 1” Style

All papers must be in **Word** or **PDF** format and MAY NOT EXCEED 4 PAGES IN LENGTH, including figures, tables and references. Any papers exceeding 4 pages will be charged a \$50 fee per additional page.

Papers should be formatted with double columns and should be single-spaced, 10 point Times New Roman font.

Also, do not change the margins as they have been set in the template: Top-1 inch, Right-1 inch, Bottom-1 inch, Left-1 inch. Text should be justified.

Do not add page numbers to your paper. We will insert these later.

All papers must be submitted online via the JCIS website: [www.jcis.org](http://www.jcis.org). Papers must be in Microsoft Word (.doc) or Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) format and cannot be larger than 5,000 Kb. Filenames should be as follows: firstname\_lastname.doc or firstname\_lastname.pdf.

To submit your paper, please go to the JCIS website at [www.jcis.org](http://www.jcis.org), click on the “Call for Papers” link and then “On-line Submission” tool. After uploading your paper, you will be directed to an information page where you will need to provide name, contact, and paper information as well as indicate to which conference track the paper is being submitted.

See below for submission deadlines:

### December 1, 2004

Paper due for authors requiring early notification.

### January 15, 2005

Paper due for standard submission.

### February 1, 2005

Notification of acceptance - invitation letters sent to authors who require early notification.

### March 15, 2005

Notification of acceptance - invitation letters sent to authors for the standard submission.

### April 30, 2005

Final camera ready papers due (including invited papers)

### April 30, 2005

Deadline for authors with accepted and invited papers to register and submit the minimum \$180 publication fee/registration deposit, or early discounted registration fees.

If your paper is accepted, you must submit a registration deposit/paper publication fee of \$180 or the early discounted registration fee by April 30, 2005. Papers for which a deposit or full registration fees have not been submitted will NOT be included in the proceedings. NO EXCEPTIONS unless approved by the JCIS conference manager in writing.

Use the “Header 2” style, shown above, for subheads. Following is an example of a graphic and caption (“Figure” style).

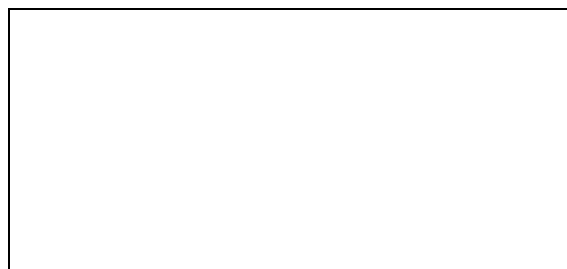


Fig. 1: Use “Figure” style here.
